- Resources are correct for the task, available on site by the agreed time, and checked for serviceability in accordance with work instructions and standard worksite practices.
- 3. Pre-operational checks are carried out in accordance with work instruction sheet.

SPECIFIC OUTCOME 3

Use lifting equipment to lift and move the load.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

- 1. The lifting and moving task is carried out in accordance with the work instruction sheet, permit conditions and drawings.
- 2. Safety precautions are applied and adhered to in accordance with OHS Act (applicable to the use of the lifting equipment).
- 3. No damage is incurred on the lifting equipment, related accessories and fellow workers.
- 4. The load is inspected for damage and its end position conforms to work instructions. as reflected on drawing or job requirement.
